### **Beaverhead Watershed Grants**

- During the last month Zach submitted a Bureau of Reclamation Water Smart application to do more work in the Red Rock. This would provide \$100,000 over 2 years. This is the same grant he was hired through.
- We were awarded a \$4,000 grant from Montana Trout Unlimited to help cover our insect monitoring lab expenses this year.
- The Cornell Park EA is open for comment. If the CD is willing, letters of support will definitely help. The project needs to be approved by an FWP commission, and they'll want to see local support.
- Truck- try for exempt plates
- Next insect monitoring set for Monday. Postponed last week due to weather.
- There is a Zoom meeting on May 12<sup>th</sup> for explaining water rights.

- The Watercraft inspection station is running smoothly, they had found 1 mussel boat twice. The same boat came through the station twice and each time they found more mussels, the mussels were dead and not viable, he was headed for lake Coeur d'Alene.
- Jess went to the soil health workshop and Byron was there also. A class from UMW
  came as well. We discussed how expensive ranching and farming has become. Rotational
  grazing has lots of promise but high initial cost with fencing. More workshops are needed
  that focus on the cost benefits of new soil health practices.
- Our ARPA irrigation grant was ranked 16 out of 34 so we will see how many they decide to fund.
